

RIDER INFORMATION BVBF 2016

HELMETS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL RIDERS:

You can start when or where you want, but take note of rest stop opening and closing times below. Please obey all traffic laws and practice common group rider courtesies such as informing riders that you are passing. Hwy 24's shoulder becomes narrow at the town of Granite. *Please ride single file at all times. The Colorado State Patrol will be on the course to promote rider and motorist safety. Bikes are vehicles in Colorado and are expected to obey Colorado's vehicle laws. Don't get a ticket.*

PARKING:

Parking at the Vista Inn is for hotel guests only. Parking is available at the Sangre De Cristo Electric Assn, on Hwy 24, 0.7 of a mile north of McPhelemy Park and at the United Congregation Church of Christ one block north of the Park, left on Brookdale Ave, then take right at Pleasant. The Church parking lot is on your left. Porta potties are available at both parking locations. No overnight or Saturday parking is allowed in McPhelemy Park and no parking at the Church on Sunday morning.

RIDER WRIST BANDS AND HELMET NUMBERS:

You *must wear* your BVBF wristband and *it must be visible* to receive rest stop food, lunch, sag support, and entrance to the post ride party. Have your rider identification number attached to your helmet.
